On **16/17 December 2019**, the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition will organize the

2nd Research on Innovation, Science and Entrepreneurship Workshop

The goal of the **RISE2 Workshop** is to stimulate an in-depth discussion of a select number of empirical research papers. It offers **Ph.D. students and Junior Post-docs** an opportunity to present their work and to receive feedback.

Overview

The **RISE2 Workshop** will focus on the following areas:

- Science of Science
- Knowledge Diffusion
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- Intellectual Property Rights
- Innovation Motives

The **RISE2 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and 14 paper presentations. Each paper is discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships. The workshop venue is the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition in Munich.

We invite submissions of full papers or extended abstracts (of at least three pages) from PhD students and Junior Postdocs working in the fields of Economics or Management. Please send your submissions as a PDF file until **Sunday, 28 July 2019** to rise_workshop@ip.mpg.de.

Acceptance notifications will be announced by **mid of August 2019** and the workshop registration will be open until **30 September 2019**. The full paper version of your submission is due on **1 November 2019**.

A limited number of scholarships is offered for researchers who do not receive financial conference assistance from their home institution. Please indicate in your application whether the participation is contingent on receiving a travel grant.
