On **6/7 December 2021**, the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition will organize the

4th Research on Innovation, Science and Entrepreneurship Workshop

The goal of the **RISE4 Workshop** is to stimulate an in-depth discussion of a select number of empirical research papers. It offers **Ph.D. students and Junior Post-docs** an opportunity to present their work and to receive feedback.

Overview

The **RISE4 Workshop** will focus on the following areas:

- Science of Science
- Knowledge Diffusion
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship
- Intellectual Property Rights
- Innovation Motives & Behavior

The **RISE4 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and approx. 10 paper presentations. Each paper is discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships. Ideally, the workshop venue would be the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition in Munich. However, due to the current development of the Covid-19 pandemic this year's RISE4 workshop will be held online again.
