## 5<sup>th</sup> Research on Innovation, Science and Entrepreneurship Workshop

The goal of the **RISE5 Workshop** is to stimulate an in-depth discussion of a select number of empirical research papers. It offers **Ph.D. students and Junior Post-docs** an opportunity to present their work and to receive feedback.

### Overview

- Innovation Motives & Behavior
- Artificial Intelligence

The **RISE5 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and approx. 10 paper presentations. Each paper is discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships. The workshop venue will be the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition in Munich.

### Paper submission procedure

We invite submissions of full papers or extended abstracts (of at least three pages) from Ph.D. students and Junior Postdocs working in the fields of Economics or Management. Please submit your paper or extended abstract as a PDF file until **Thursday, 15 September 2022**, via the [submission tool](#).

Acceptance notifications will be announced by **mid of October 2022** and the workshop registration will be open until **01 November 2022**. The full paper version of your submission is due on **15 November 2022**.

A limited number of travel grants will be offered for researchers who do not receive financial conference assistance from their home institution. Please indicate in your application whether the participation is contingent on receiving a travel grant.
