- Innovation and Entrepreneurship

- Innovation Motives & Behavior
- Artificial Intelligence

The **RISE6 Workshop** will feature a keynote lecture and approx. 10 paper presentations. Each paper will be discussed by a senior researcher with particular emphasis on the research design and the ability to identify causal relationships.
